Social Media becoming an issue at EM/HS



Over **90%** of the student **conflicts** that occur at EM/HS, stem from one of the social media sites that students are registered with. We need your help as parents to help monitor student activity.

Listed below are some tips that can help you monitor these trending behaviors better known as "Cyber Bullying."

Social Media Monitoring Tips for Parents

- Set parameters on cell phone/laptop usage at home.
- Have a "charging station" in the kitchen, so it does not have to go to student's room for charging.
- When your students are using their devices, have them sit with their backs to you, so you can see their screens.
- Anytime your students create a new account, sit next to them, so you know the usernames, passwords, and abilities of the site.
 - o Then **check their usage** occasionally to hold them accountable.
- Have your students **explain the purpose** of the site they are using/accessing.
