## Estill High School's 2016 Wall of Fame Honoree of the Week:

# Akime Heyward-Deering Chief Petty Officer Class of 1999



Chief Petty Officer Deering, Class of 1999 graduate from Estill High School, located in Estill, South Carolina. In July 1999, she enlisted in the United States Navy at the age of 17 and reported boot camp at Recruit Training Command, Great Lakes, Illinois.

Upon her departure from Grate Lakes, Akime traveled to Aviation Maintenance Administration School, Meridian Mississippi. Postgraduation, she reported to Air Test and Evaluation Squadron One Naval Station Patuxent River, Maryland in January of 2000. Her next tour of duty led her overseas to Naval Air Station Sigonella, Italy in January 2002. Akime was assigned to Strike Fighter Squadron Eight Two Marine Corp Air Station Beaufort, South Carolina in August 2004 and deployed onboard USS Abraham Lincoln (CVN-72). December 2005, she was transferred to Naval Surface Warfare Center Panama City, Florida serving as the Maintenance Administration Department Leading Petty Officer. December 2007, Chief Deering traveled to The Center for Naval Aviation Technical Training, Naval Air Station Pensacola, FL where her official certification as an Aviation System Analysis/Database Administrator was achieved. April 2008, Akime reported to Helicopter Maritime Strike Squadron Four Two Mayport, Florida and deployed onboard USS San Jacinto (CG56). Her next tour of duty at Commander Helicopter Maritime Strike Wing Atlantic would lead her to serve with Elliot Jones and Jarod Hopkins as Aviation Wing Inspectors. In 2014, she was selected as Sailor of the Year. September 2015, Akime was advance to the rank of Chief Petty Officer. She is now serving as the Leading Chief Petty Officer for Logs & Records, Database Analysis/System Admin and Sexual Assault Prevention & Response Victim Advocate for 256 Sailors at Helicopter Maritime Strike Squadron Four Six.

In addition to multiple unit and campaign awards, Chief Deering's personal awards include the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (7 awards). She is also qualified as Enlisted Aviation and Surface Warfare Specialist.

She is married to the Mr. Melvrick J. Deering of Jacksonville, FL and has one child, Jaydon Dexter. Her mother, Janice Heyward and her brother, Deunterriyo Heyward lives in Lena, South Carolina.
