

## WHAT IS TITLE I?

Title I is a program that provides additional academic support and learning opportunities for students at schools with high percentages of disadvantaged children.

Any school with 40% or more students on free or reduced lunch is eligible for Title I funds

The program is intended to help ensure that all students meet state academic standards.




#### WHAT IS A SCHOOLWIDE PROGRAM?
