

EHS Graduation Update

As of May 19, 2020, the following information is available for the 2019-20 graduation ceremony:

- 1. Senior fees are due prior to receipt of diploma or participation in the graduation ceremony.
- 2. Graduation will be on Thursday, June 4, 2020 @ 9:00 a.m. (In case of rain, graduation will be held June 5, 2020 @ 9:00 a.m.) Anyone arriving after 9:00 a.m. will not be allowed to enter the campus.
- EHS is hosting a drive-up graduation. Students have earned four tickets. The graduate does not need a ticket. Maximum vehicles, allowed: 2 (car, truck, or SUV; no motorcycles, ATVs, spiders & scooters).
- 4. Graduates will report to the school @ 7:30 a.m., before the ceremony, to get their cars prepared for the graduation and to get in position for the line-up.
- 5. All graduates must be in line and be ready for graduation by 8:30 a.m. Estill High School will be honoring all CDC regulatory procedures regarding safety and social distancing.
- 6. Placards will be placed in the window of the graduates' car on the left hand side of the dashboard along with a number for your position in line.
- 7. Students will be allowed to decorate the trunk of the car that they are riding in. (A design model will be in the parking lot for you to follow and a picture will be emailed to you.)
- 8. Do not put any balloons on your car. Balloons will be given to each graduate at the school on the day of graduation.
- 9. 2 poster pictures will be given to each graduate to place on their car.
- 10. Graduates will receive their diplomas and a gift bag. A photo will be taken by the photographer upon receipt of their diploma.
- 11. After graduation, students will participate in the "EHS Parade of Graduates" and celebrate through the Town of Estill ending at Tyson's Auto Lot.
